



## Town Update – COVID-19

Date: Thursday, May 7, 2020

The Town of Surf City will continue to work with County, State, and Federal agencies in response to the COVID-19 emergency. The Town's Emergency Operations Center is operating on Day 49 in efforts to coordinate and implement our response. We will provide periodic updates to keep you informed. At this point the following actions have been taken:

  - a. Local restrictions currently lifted and re-opened:
    - i. Soundside Park – Boat ramp, open-space, and boardwalk
    - ii. All Public Beach Accesses
    - iii. Surf City Disc Golf Course
  - b. Local restrictions scheduled to be lifted on May 8, 2020 at 5pm:
    - i. Public Parking Re-opens
    - ii. Short-term Rentals Resume
  - c. Local restrictions still in effect:
    - i. Town buildings closed
    - ii. Public restrooms closed
    - iii. Playgrounds and shelters closed
