Approval of Agenda

Mr. Helms made a motion to approve the agenda. Mr. Torres seconded the motion, and it was carried.

Old Business

1. Ordinance Amendment 2021-12 – Chapter 11 Nuisances Art. II. Noise

Mr. Breuer explained the decibel meter and how the system would be read.

The meeting was recessed so that the audience could hear the music at 70db at 100' away demonstration.

Mrs. Batts stated that the noise as presented was at a controlled level. She mentioned that if a daycare facility was to move beside a bar than the bar should have first standing.

Mr. Torres stated that based on his experience he would like to recommend to 80db as the decibel level for Friday and Saturday, and 75db for the lowest levels.

Mr. Helms stated per his experience he thought the ordinance as presented was a good medium, but he was willing to do 80 as the max.

Mr. Fowler stated that he too thinks that 80 is a decent comprise. It discussed that sound travels and that everyone needs to do their part and work together. She spoke on getting the facts from staff or council before going on social media.

Mr. Shugarts stated had ten phone calls today because the board was taking music away from Surf City. He stated the council and the mayor have the best interest in mind. He asked that you reach out to the council and staff if you have questions regarding business going on in town.

Mr. Helms stated the board is trying to reach a happy livable place for everyone.

Mr. Torres made a motion to accept the ordinance as presented with the amendment to raise the level to 80db. Mr. Shugarts seconded the motion, it carried.
